There are many parallels between food and water insecurity. One difference, however, is that we have no metric for assessing household-level water insecurity, while there are several for measuring food security at the level of the household. In this topical lunch, we discussed potential uses for a household-level water insecurity access scale, some preliminary data on water insecurity from Kenya, and identified faculty with expertise in a number of departments interested in developing such a scale. We will be pursuing funding to support scale development from the National Institute of Health and several foundations.
