Poloncarz issued an <u>executive order</u> last spring enforcing the Paris Agreement in Erie County shortly after the Trump administration pulled out of the agreement. While the recently completed greenhouse gas inventory showed much of Erie County's gains were unintentional, Poloncarz said it also shows that meeting the Paris goals are not as difficult as federal executive officials contend.
